QUALIFICATION: KOHAKU SYSTEM (flags). The following kata:

Groups: 1B, 1A, 2B, 2A, 3B, 3A, 4B, 4A, 5B, 5A, 6B, 6A, 7B, 7A, 8B, 8A, 9B, 9A, 10B, 10A, 11B, 12B:  
 TAIKYOKU-SHODAN, HEIAN-SHODAN, HEIAN-NIDAN, HEIAN-SANDAN, HEIAN-YONDAN, HEIAN-GODAN, TEKKI-SHODAN  
 – SHITEI kata according to belt level – (Shushin choses kata).  
 Groups: 11A, 12A: BASSAI-DAI, JION, EMPI, KANKU-DAI – SHITEI kata – (Shushin choses kata)  
 Groups: 13 B A, 14 B A, 15 B A, 16 B A – perform TOKUI kata according to belt level.

KOHAKU SYSTEM – until 4 finalists.

FINAL PART: All groups perform TOKUI kata. The same kata from qualification part can be repeated. Point system.

\* Note: Kyu belts final kata (TOKUI) according to belt level. Brown belts (3.Kyu - 1.Kyu) in the final are obligatory performed by Heian or BASSAI-DAI, JION, EMPI, KANKU-DAI, JIIN.  
 In case of low number of competitors in a group, groups can be joined. Competitors of certain age can perform in two age categories.\*

17. **KATA TEAM:** 16 years and above. The number of teams per club or country is not limited.

17A MEN – Team 3+1 (or 2 men and 1 woman) mix, 17B WOMEN – Team 3+1 (or 2 women + 1 man) mix

The number of teams is not limited. Teams can be all men or all women or mix as explained above. They can also be mixed by age categories (cadet, senior, master).

4 male and 4 female teams go to final. Teams can perform the same kata in qualification and final part. If a club has more than 1 team in a category, please mark this in application form with 17A 1, 17A 2...

18. **YAKU-SOKU KUMITE:** 16 years and above. The number of teams per club or country is not limited.

The teams can be mixed – man and women together and different age categories together. Team is 2+1. SKIF rules, point system.

If there is more than one team from a country or club, please mark 18A, 18B...

Competitors of a certain age can compete in two age categories. In case of low number of competitors in a group, groups can be joined or in case of three (3) competitors in a category each faces each.

• Kumite rules:

2 minutes, IPPON-HAN-SHOBU (3 Wazaries or 1 Ippon and 1 Wazari), maximum 2 extensions, each 2 minutes.

All positive and negative points are taken into the first extensions, the second extension starts from zero points.

If the result is still undecided after the second extensions, referees must decide the winner. There is no repassage, there is fight for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

29. **KUMITE TEAM:** 17 years and above. The number of teams per club or country is not limited.

29A – Men – Team 3+1 reserve, 29B – Women – Team 3+1 reserve

The number of teams per country is not limited. Teams can be mixed by age (cadet, senior, master).

• Kumite team rules:

2 minutes, IPPON-SHOBU (2 Wazaries or 1 Ippon), no extensions, S.K.I.F. rules.

In case a country applies more teams in a category, mark it as follows: 29A1, 29A2, ... or 29B1, 29B2...

All competitors in kumite MUST HAVE gum shield, white gloves S.K.I.F. standard; men can wear groin protectors, women chest protectors. Other protection gear is not allowed.

The competition will pass according to S.K.I.F. and S.K.I.F. Slovenia rules and regulations.

• **OTHER INFORMATION:** S.K.I.F. Slovenia appoints referees. All countries and teams can delegate a S.K.I.F. licensed referee. Referees must wear a uniform – S.K.I.F. rules.

The number of competitors is not limited. The competitors take part on their own responsibility. We recommend medical examination and insurance to all participants.

The draw will be made according to alphabetical order of participating team / countries after the application dead-line.
