INDIVIDUAL KATA QUALIFICATIONS:

Individual kata competitions are conducted by groups and age categories using the KOHAKU SYSTEM – flag system.

For groups: 1A,1B,2A,2B,3A,3B,4A,4B,5A,5B,6A,6B,7A,7B,8A,8B,9A,9B,10A,10B,11B,12B,13B,14B – the following katas are mandatory: TAIKYOKU-SHODAN, HEIAN-SHODAN, HEIAN-NIDAN, HEIAN-SANDAN, HEIAN-YONDAN, HEIAN-GODAN, TEKKI-SHODAN – SHITEI kata.

SHITEI KATA within the belt level of both competitors, is determined by the Shushin (chief referee).

For groups: 11A,12A,13A,14A – the mandatory katas are: BASSAI-DAI, JION, EMPI, KANKU-DAI – SHITEI kata

The KOHAKU SYSTEM – qualifications continue until the top 4 competitors (finalists) are determined. If there are five or fewer competitors in a group, the competition proceeds directly to the final.

Groups: 15,16,17,18,19 (B+A) – perform their own TOKUI kata, appropriate to competitor's belt level.

INDIVIDUAL KATA FINALS:

In the finals, all groups perform their own final TOKUI kata, appropriate to their belt rank, regardless of whether the competitor performed the same kata in the KOHAKU qualification rounds.

In the finals is used point system. Placements from 5th to 8th place are determined based on the rankings of the top 4 finalists. Competitors of certain birth years are allowed to compete in two age categories in kata.

20.TEAM KATA: 15 years and older

20A – MEN'S team 3+1 – (or 2 men + 1 woman – mixed team)

20B – WOMEN'S team 3+1- (or 2 women + 1 man – mixed team)

Each country or club may enter an unlimited number of teams. Teams in kata may consist of male or female competitors, or may be mixed by gender (male-female).

If a country or club enters more than one team, the teams must be marked in the entry list as 20A1,20A2...20B1,20B2,...

If fewer than 8 teams are entered, only one round (direct final) will be held. If more than 8 teams are entered, two rounds will be conducted (qualifications and final). The top 4 teams advance to the final; in this case 2 katas are performed.

21.YAKO-SOKU KUMITE: 15 years and older

Teams in Yako-soku kumite may be mixed by gender (male-female) or by age category (cadet-men/woman-master men/woman). A team consists of 2 competitors + 1 reserve. The Yako-soku kumite competition is conducted in accordance with S.K.I.F. rules, using the score system. If a country or club enters more than one team, the teams must be marked in the entry list as 21A,21B,...

Competitors of certain birth years are allowed to compete in two kumite age groups.

Kumite bouts last 2 minutes, IPPON-HAN-SHOBU (up to three Wazari, or one Ippon and one Wazari). A maximum of two extensions of 2 minutes is allowed. In the first extension, all positive and negative points are carried over. The second extension starts with a new score sheet; if there is still no winner, the referees must decide and declare the final winner.

All kumite competitors must mandatory wear mouthguards and white gloves according to S.K.I.F. standars. Men must wear groin protectors and women must wear chest protectors. For younger age categories (up to 15 years of age), a body protector worn under the karate gi is permitted. All other protective equipment is not allowed.

Kumite competitions are conducted using the K.O. system (elimination) without repechage, except for the bout for 3rd-4th place.

Kata and kumite competitions are held according to the propositions and in accordance with the competition and referee rules of S.K.I.F. and the S.K.I.F. Federation of Slovenia.

35.TEAM KUMITE:17 years and older

35A-MEN

35B-WOMEN

Each country or club may enter an unlimited number of teams. Kumite teams may be mixed by age (above 17 years). A team consist of 3 competitors plus 1 reserve. Team kumite bouts last 2 minutes, IPPON-SHOBU (two Wazari or one Ippon), without extensions, in accordance with S.K.I.F. rules. If a club or country enters more than one team, the teams must be marked in the entry list as 35A1,35A2,..35B1,35B2,..

OTHER TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS:

All competitors in kata and kumite compete at their own responsibility.

Referees are delegated by the S.K.I.F. Federation of Slovenia. All registered teams or countries are kindly requested to also register their referees, who must hold a valid refereeing license. Referees assigned to officiate will be designated by the Chief Referee of the tournament and must officiate in official referee uniforms (dark blue blazer, grey trousers, white shirt and tie), in accordance with S.K.I.F. rules.

Each invited country or team may register an unlimited number of competitors in the announced categories.

When registering a competitor in a category, only the year of birth is considered, not the date of birth.
